Very glad to get the corrections for the two PMs. I'm filing them in the files of other corrections of which I've made notes, for when I get back to them. I'd expected to months ago.

Your 7/16: Ramblers- I'm no car expert or buff, but I believe there was a time all their stationwagons came through with a built-on luggage rack. Itek: I think there is a typo in your quotation, but it is interesting and not at all what his Eminence JEH said. I'm glad someone is finally "exasperated" over the moving of the sign. About time. That could be useful as a check on FBI dependability, including in court.
