At 9:00 PM today, JAMES ELBERT ROMACK, 10825  
Beverbrook Dr., Casa View, Dallas, Texas, BR 9-2831  
telephonically contacted this office in regard to an  
article appearing in the March 6, 1964 edition of the  
Dallas Times Herald. The instant article by DARWIN  
PAYNE concerned one JAMES RICHARD WORRELL who claims  
to have observed an unknown man run from the back door  
of the TSBSD immediately after the Assassination of  
President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

ROMACK stated he works and worked for at the  
pertinent time the MKT Railroad on the loading docks  
immediately behind the TSBSD. ROMACK stated on Nov.  
22, 1963 he was eating lunch on the loading dock behind  
the TSBSD when he heard three shots. Immediately after-  
wards he saw a Dallas Policeman running along the  
east side of the TSBSD north toward him. ROMACK allegedly  
told the officer he would watch the back of the TSBSD and  
the officer went on back toward the front of the building.

ROMACK stated that subsequent to hearing the three  
shots he did not leave the area of the MKT loading dock  
and was able to observe all activity behind the TSBSD. In  
doing so, ROMACK stated he definitely never saw anyone  
leave by the back door of the TSBSD as alleged by WORRELL  
in above mentioned newspaper story.

ROMACK stated he would be available for interview  
at his home or place of business.
