Second Jack Ruby Trial Is Set at Wichita Falls

DALLAS, Tex., Dec. 6 (AP) Jack Ruby will be tried the second time for the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald in Wichita Falls, Judge Louis Holland announced today.

The Montague jurist disclosed the new site after a conference with State and defense lawyers this morning. No trial date has been set.

Wichita Falls is a city of

some 150,000 persons about 140 miles northwest of Dallas.

Ruby, former operator of a Dallas night club, received a death sentence in his trial here before District Judge Joe B. Brown. The Texas Court of Criminal Appeals, however, set aside the conviction, holding that the trial judge had committed legal errors. It ordered a new trial outside Dallas.
