

Claim Filed Against Ruby

The federal government has filed a claim of \$45,637 for back taxes against the estate of Jack Ruby, the man who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, an Internal Revenue Service source confirmed Thursday.

The IRS said the claim became a matter of public record Tuesday and is for taxes dating back to 1956 over five separate tax periods.

Ruby died of cancer in January.

Oswald was named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President Kennedy.
