Ruby Is Named in Tax Claim le

n-DALLAS, Tex. (AP) - The y federal government has filed a oclaim of \$45.637.43 for back tax-es against Jack Ruby, who kill-ed Lee Harvey Oswald. The m Warren Commission called Oswald the slayer of President Kennedy.

Ruby died last January of ne cancer.

The claim, Internal Revenue re of Service officials said Thursday, es is for taxes dating back to 1956 during five separate tax periods.

The service first filed an income tax claim against him for nd \$14,106.37 in 1956. A second claim specifies \$16,204.90 in unhe paid taxes plus fees and fines of ia-\$6,497.99. There were some les-Io- ser claims.

There has been no official inor dication of the size of Ruby's estate, but it is not expected to be large.
