Attached is Chicago FBI 44-1114-774. It refers to receipt of a letter, not provided, from one Ray Russell, who knew an address ~~of~~^{of} the recent escapee, James Earl Ray, and even the alias under which Ray was, his brother's.

Obviously this is something that required ~~an~~ investigation, the beginning of which is entered in this record.

The results of this investigation have not been provided to me.

If there was an interview with Russell and his name was obliterated, then I would not have any way of knowing.

If his name was withheld, it is also obvious that the withholding is not justified.

When and how the original Russell knew the address and ~~alias~~^{alias} of Ray also is potentially important information that I presume the FBI obtained.

Enclosed for Memphis and Savannah is one Xerox copy of letter and envelope sent to Mrs. DONNELLY by RAY RUSSELL.

Mrs. GLORIA DONNELLY, owner, 2731 North Sheffield, Chicago, Illinois, made available a letter from RAY RUSSELL and the envelope the letter came in, to Agents of the Chicago Division. For the information of Savannah, investigation has previously established that JAMES EARL RAY, using the name of JOHN LARRY RAYNS, rented a room, which was the rear basement apartment at 2731 North Sheffield, and resided at that address from April 30, 1967, to sometime in May or June, 1967.

Mrs. DONNELLY contacted Agents due to the fact that letter signed by RAY RUSSELL, who is apparently an inmate at the prison at Reidsville, Georgia, refers to the rear basement apartment and mentions the name, JOHN LARRY RAYNS. Mrs. DONNELLY cannot recall the identity of RAY RUSSELL. She has checked her rent records and cannot find anyone by that name that rented from them. Mrs. DONNELLY also advised she does not understand why RUSSELL would be writing to her asking her for help in getting money.
