Dear Karen Sawle,

While I would probably still be continuing the work I began a decade ago, without prospect of publication, were it not for letters like yours of the 30th., they do help and I do appreciate yours.

Please note our address for the past seven years. We left Hyattstown in 1967.

Because you want the Whitewash book and because I am the only source, to send them herewith will save us both trouble and cost. The total charge including handling, postage and insurance is only \$15.00 when the three are ordered at once.

Oswald in New Orleans, which I did not print, is out of print. I have only a few copies and I must ask for each \$21, which is what electrostatic replacement costs me.

I enclose a flyer on my book on the King assassination. It is the backstopping of the recent May court decisions that order a hearing and hopefully thereafter a trial, for the first time.

I would send this anyway, but because you are going to be a lawyer and because law schools do not teach investigation, I do think that the method I followed could be helpful to you if you intend to practise criminal law. (Where I quote the newspapers I later obtained the court transcripts and did not change the manuscript to show that it was all laid out and known without access to the court records - so why didn't the media do it?)

If I was in any way influential in your deciding to become a lawyer I am pleased because - believe we need more women lawyers and particularly in criminal law do women need criminal lawyers. Or those conversant enough with criminal law to look out for their needs and to protect them and their rights.

Were you closer I could indeed use research assistance! and would welcome it.

Because of the distance, however, for the most part this is impractical. However, if your local or college libraries are good ones, there may be occasions when some research and xeroxes could be quite helpful. Even copies of entries in Who's Who, which is not readily available out in the country, where I live. Or New York Times stories, things like that.

Thanks for the offer. I may ask for library help.

Sorry you are not closer.

Dear Mr. Weisberg,

When John Kennedy was murdered, I was just 10 yrs old. I understood little of what had actually taken place, but to this day I can recall that it was the first time I had ever seen both my parents crying. Like everyone else, I grew up believing that he had been killed by a lone, crazed assassin, and I never found any reason to question that belief.

Well, about two years ago I had an attack of boredom and searched the house out for something to read. The only book around that I hadn't read was Mark Lane's Rush to Judgment. I was desperate for something to do, so I started reading it. I ended up staying up the whole night reading, and in the morning, both my curiosity and my anger was roused. I realized that there was much more to the assassination than I had been taught, and was enraged that the investigation was obviously a "whitewash". Since that day, I have read everything I could get my hands on about the assassination, including every volume of the Warren Report, and have studied every picture I could

find. Since I got such a late start studying the assassination, I only recently got around to reading your "Whitewash" books. They are by far the most detailed, believable and truthfully, frightening books I have read on the assassination. I spent many sleepless nights with books + pictures spread out on my bed while I took notes. My personal investigation of the assassination has become an obsession and has ~~be~~ been a great influence on my life. Before my curiosity was stirred, I was not terribly interested in history or politics. I was a pre-med student with hopes of becoming a surgeon. But once I started reading about the assassination, the involvement of the FBI and CIA and their awesome power, I became involved in politics. Next year I will be entering law school and would eventually like to "run for office." I know I have a somewhat idealistic view of my own potential role in politics, but I really feel that I can, and in fact, must get myself into a position where I have "influence", if I am ever going to actually do something to reopen the investigation + get everything into the open.

Well, I've really gotten carried away in this letter. I really just wanted to express my thanks and admiration for your books. I have read library

copies of them, but I would like to get my own copies. I would therefore appreciate it if you would send me information on how to order any books you have written on the assassination. I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience. Also, I realize you have probably gotten many letters from "Assassination buffs", but I wish you would consider this offer; I am quite serious in my investigation and in my desire to see this conspiracy & cover up brought into the open. Therefore, I would like to volunteer myself to help in any research etc. you might need for any future books. This investigation must be carried on, and I would be willing to do anything to help with it. Again, many thanks, and please keep this investigation alive.
