FOLLOWING IS SUMMARY OF MARCH THIRTY ACTIVITIES.

A MARCH WAS HELD IN DOWNTOWN MEMPHIS AREA WITH  
 LARGE NUMBERS OF WHITE PARTICIPANTS INCLUDED FOR THE FIRST TIME.  
 MARCH COMMENCED APPROXIMATELY TWO THIRTY P.M. AT CLAYBORN TEMPLE,  
 WAS ORDERLY AND CONCLUDED AT APPROXIMATELY THREE THIRTY P.M.  
 NO INCIDENTS OR ARRESTS IN CONNECTION WITH MARCH OF APPROXIMATELY  
 TWO HUNDRED PARTICIPANTS. OTHER ACTIVITIES INCLUDED EARLY  
 MORNING ARRESTS IN CONNECTION WITH LOOTING IN VARIOUS SECTIONS  
 OF CITY RESTRICTED TO NEIGHBORHOOD LIQUOR AND GROCERY STORES.  
 VARIOUS TRASH FIRES REPORTED DURING EVENING HOURS. NO MAJOR  
 INCIDENTS KNOWN TO HAVE OCCURRED. P.
