Robert Patrick Lyons, 2520 Marion Avenue, Memphis,
Tempessee, unlisted Telephone was interviewed at his
place of employment, Cruzen Equipment Co., Inc., 160 Yest
Mallory Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee, Telephone 947-3146, and
was apprised of the identities of interviewing Special Agents
of the FEI. Lyons furnished the following information:

Lyons advised that he is familiar with an individual by the name Bill Sartor, whom he mot through Marie Geisendorf, Aka. Marie Lyons, shortly after the death of Martin Luther King, Jr. Lyons stated he was introduced in August, 1968, to an individual known as Nick Flannery, who stated he was from the Justice Department, Mashington, D. C. Lyons advised that originally Bill Sartor had asked Coisendorf to assertate formation from Negroes in the Memphis community concerning the death of Martin Luther King, Jr., but then asked Pat Lyon, to obtain any information concerning the death of Martin Luther King, Jr., with the possibility that the "Mafia" was connected with King's death. Lyons advised that he made no attempt to ascertain any information concerning the Mafia and the death of Martin Luther King, Jr.

He stated that when he met Flannery. He repeated to Flannery exactly what Earter had previously teld him. Namely that Joe Cacameci met with James Earl May at a Lion farvier Station on the day before the death of Martin Luther Ming. Mestated that this information came from Sarter and who in no way information he developed on his own. He stated that Cacamedi is known to him as a cosmetics salesman in the lemphis area and is known to drink frequently in Caesar's Louige. Which according to Lyons is owned by Ernie Earrasso. Lyons states Earrasso is a former schoolmate of his and a legitimate businessman in the Memphis community. Lyons states Earrasso is a negrew of Frank Liberto, when Lyons described as a local Memphis businessman. He identified Larry Max, Aka, Larry and as a worker on a tug boat on the Mississippi River. He stated neither Max nor Cacamedi is known to him as a professional killer. Lyons states both Max and Cacamedi are employed in the Memphis area and his only association with them has been

Lyons advised that Sartor inquired about Claude Costroll, who is known to Lyons as a possible segregationist in the Mariais and . Lyons stated Sartor is of the opinion that if a car was used to go to Millington, as described by the new media them. Cockrell was the logical person, although as reason was given by Sartor for this. Lyons said Sartor was of the opinion that if another white Mustang was used to assist the killer of Ming in escaping the Memphis area, as referred to by the name media concerning the CB radio broadcast, then he considered Costroll to be the logical person to have a private airplane waiting at Millington.

Lyons further stated that Sarter is of the contact that officers who were suspended for alle of policy brut lity within the past year are involved in the staying of the fitte Luther King. According to Lyons, Earter does not give Lay basis for this.

Sartor told Lyons that he has contact with the this in New Orleans, New York, and Philadelphia, although he acted only one individual, one Solo or Sola, as his contact lith the Mafia in New Orleans.

Lyons stated he has had numerous casual mosting, with Sartor and during this period Lyons has volumesared cort in information of his personal life to sartor, including facts regarding the tragic death of Lyons' wife. Inite volumestring information to Sartor regarding his wife's illness, Lyons here tioned that his wife had become addicted to the use of narrotical during her illness and in this regard had cooperated with Pegeral Drug Administration Supervisor Don Voight. Larger had asked Lyons to ascertain information regarding narrotics from Voight.

Lyons described server as being unreliable and as attributing false information to Lyons, which information was actually rumored by Eartor. According to Lyons, Server, by originating these rumors in different areas in Monthis, it able to get a "play back" from various sources, which he uses as a means of lending credence to his stories.
