My dear Harold Weishergs:

You are correct in your recollection that the police searches turned up live ammunition in the JFK case.

After I received your reply to my query about your statement in Carr Opn, p. 109, a light went on. I recalled that Marina testified that there ^{were} bullets in a small box.

My recall was also correct. The bullets were not 6.5. They may have been for the revolver: .38 caliber.

I spent all day yesterday (Oct. 18) checking. (We old ones do not have much time left.) There was not anything about ammunition in the testimony of Rose or Stoval. Stoval Ex. H, the property list, contained no bullet item.

I shuddered. Would I ^{have} to go through all of Marina's stuff? Luck had it that I did not. The answer I was looking for can be found in her February, 1994, testimony. In that testimony she states there were no bullets in the Paine garage.
