The Warren Commission was appointed ~~September~~^{November} 27, 1963.

Its report, in page proof, was given to LBJ and to the press, with an embargo of three days, September 24, 1964. Bound printed copies were available at the Government Printing Office 9/27, the official date of release.

You can check the date of the Commission's appointment in their Report, which you have.
