The Warren Commission report concluded that Lee Harvey Oswaid acted alone in killing the President in Dallas. Oswaid twas killed two days after the assassination by a Dallas night club owner, Jack Ruby, who later died in jail.

"I think the Warren Commission report is like a house of cards," said Senator Schweiker. "It's going to collapse."
