The enclosed book review deals with the same subject that has concerned your and Sen. Hart's intelligence subcommittee — the assassination of President John P. Kennedy and its consequences.

It considers conclusions that differ from those reached by your subcommittee. I would not thrust it upon you if I did not feel your need to be clearly aware of such differences as early as possible in the historical process in which you are involved.

This is not to criticize. The same decades of experience in foreign and domestic news that lie behind this review tell me not to underestimate your problems.
