Mr. and Mrs. DeMohrenschildts furnished additional information relating to Lee Oswald during an interview at this Embassy on December 19, 1963. Details of this interview are enclosed. The DeMohrenschildts again expressed their readiness to cooperate in any further way that might be desired in this matter.

As previously reported by telegram, the DeMohrenschildts had left Port-au-Prince for the provincial city of Cayes prior to receipt of the Department's telegram under reference. The Embassy finally located them in that city on December 17 and urged them to return to Port-au-Prince, which they did the following day, arriving in Port-au-Prince late on the night of December 18.
