Doar Mr. Lane:

Reference is made to the previous correspondence in this case in which Cocuments located in Secret Service files were disclosed to you pursuant to the stipulation and agreement in the above-styled case.

The letter dated November 13, 1976 Nr. Daye Martin, former Logal Counsel of the Secret Service, forwarded to Mr. Jeffrey Smith, Office of the Logal Advisor at the Department of State, documents originated by the Department of State which were located in the Secret Service files pertaining to the Freedom of Information request made by you. It was requested of the Department of State that they examine the Department of State documents from the Secret Service index and inform the Secret Service of their determination as to risclosure of those documents.
