Reference is made to the previous correspondence in this case in which documents located in Secret Service files were disclosed to you pursuant to the stipulation and agreement in the above-styled case.

By letter dated November 18, 1976 Mr. Dave Martin, former Legal Counsel of the Secret Service, forwarded to Mr. Jeffrey Smith, Office of the Legal Advisor at the Department of State, documents originated by the Department of State which were located in the Secret Service files pertaining to the Freedom of Information request made by you. It was requested of the Department of State that they examine the Department of State documents from the Secret Service index and inform the Secret Service of their determination as to disclosure of those documents. On Tuesday, April 5, 1977, the Secret Service Legal Counsel's office received documents from the Department of State with instructions that the documents may be released in their entirety.
