Dear Mr. Harold Weisberg,

This is in response to your request for permission to obtain a copy of the film of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy which has come to be known as the Zapruder film ("Film"), for your scholarly studies.

LMH Company, a partnership, is presently the sole owner of the original film and the copyright thereon, and it desires to cooperate to the fullest extent possible in your request.

This is to advise you that you are authorized to obtain a copy of the Film for your scholarly studies with the following restrictions and based on the following conditions.

1. The National Archives and Records Administration ("NARA") is to release a copy to you which is fixed in 2 x 2 color slide format. Reference herein to copy shall include all slides collectively and each slide separately.

2. The copy shall have affixed to it the following copyright notice:

All Rights Reserved

3. You warrant and represent by your signature below that you shall use the copy solely for scholarly study, that the copy shall not be transferred to others, that the copy shall not be publicly exhibited; displayed, or transmitted, and that the copy shall not be commercially exploited or used for obtaining remuneration, and that no reproductions shall be made of the copy or used for the foregoing purposes.


4. You shall comply with such policies and procedures as NARA may prescribe for processing your request and any costs associated with the same.

5. LMF Company shall be deemed sole owner of copyright in copies released to you, and copyright shall be deemed to subsist in said work. You shall ~~cooperate fully in the event that registration or defense of the copyright in the work is deemed necessary by LMF Company, and~~ shall take all steps necessary to reflect LMF Company's copyright ownership, and to establish the copyright protection subsisting in the work. 1-102


If you will indicate your agreement to these restrictions and conditions by signing and returning to me the two enclosed copies of this letter I will send one of them to the National Archives to authorize in accordance with the above a release of the copy to you.

Addendum to License of October 28, 1988

The following is hereby agreed to by the undersigned and is hereby incorporated as paragraph 6 of the licensing or release agreement between Harold Weisberg and LLD Company dated October 28, 1988, attached hereto:

6. You shall be prohibited from using or authorizing the use of the name of Time, Inc., or the name of any division, subsidiary or publication of Time, Inc., of any Trademark of Time, Inc., (including without limitation, the names of any trademarks relating to Time and Life Magazines, respectively), in promotional or advertising material related to the exhibition or other exploitation or utilization of the materials released and or licensed to you, in any manner or format, including, but not limited to, any reference that the Zapruder Film was ever owned by Time, Inc. or that Time Inc. ever published any frames from the Zapruder Film in any publication of Time, Inc.

It is further agreed that Time, Inc., may undertake such proceedings as Time, Inc., may desire, legal or equitable, or both, to prevent the references which are prohibited by this paragraph 6. In any and all contracts or other authorizations with regard to the materials, you shall include a provision prohibiting any and all references to Time, Inc., in such advertising or promotional material substantially in the format as contained in this paragraph 6.
