

The name Giesbrecht was originally withheld in Serial 5390 the language of which indicates earlier communications. It is Richard Giesbrecht. There are few people who have skidnated an basis for a privact claim. There is no basis for an only-source claim as the Serial itself makes clear.

The oldest reference in Mr. ~~Walt~~ Weisberg's files is an FBI record of March 6, 1964, CD 645 in the Warren Commission files.

There is almost a full page about him and his fabrications in the Toronto Daily Star of February 3, 1968/

Jon Buddy's two-and-a-half page ~~story~~ story on Giesbrecht in the Canadian MacLean's reports is dated November 1967. Like all the other stories ~~of~~ this one goes into the connection with Jim Garrison.
