Enclosed is a copy of the complaint I am filing by the same mail in federal court in Chicago against Sherman Skolnick.

Unfortunately, blinded by his pest and the involvement of WCFL, you did either no checking or less than the minimum, for his "suit" is a hodgepodge of theft, fabrication, imagination and libel, contrived to meet the insatiable demands of a lust for personal publicity, regardless of cost.
