Guard Widows Sue

SAN RAFAEL, Calif.—
The widows of three guards killed during "Soledad Brother" George Jackson's attempted escape from San Quentin prison filed lawsuits Tuesday asking for \$69 million in damages.

The suits filed in Marin County superior court charged that the deaths resulted from negligence. Each widow asked for \$23 million for herself and her children.

The plaintiffs said Warden Louis S. Nelson "knew of the fact that George Jackson and possibly other inmates were planning to attempt an escape."
