was discontinued by the Bureau as he furnished unreliable
information and information that could not be verified
or corroborated. He recently provided information to the
effect that several individuals involved in various acts
of violence in Mississippi could possibly be involved in
the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr. The person
allegedly furnishing information to the former informant
is who is believed to be mentally
disturbed and is the mother of

was involved in the bombing at

Our Jackson Office has accounted for the whereabouts of these individuals enumerated by the former
informant during the pertinent time. The mother of
was located and interviewed, and she refused
to discuss the entire matter. She denied knowing anyone
by the names as enumerated by the former informant.
Miami points out that prior interviews with the son and
daughter-in-law of indicate that she has a
mental problem.

In view of the alleged mental condition of the mother of and in view of the past performance. AUG 14 1959 of the former informant, coupled with the possibility that he may be fabricating the entire situation, Miami is being instructed to have no further contact with the former informant in regard to this alleged conspiracy. We are also instructing Miami, was well as other interested offices, not to conduct any further investigation; however, if any information comes to their attention they should notify the Bureau, submit same with recommandations and take no further action.
