
This is to acknowledge your letter of December 6, 1975, enclosing your check for \$5.70.

The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) provides for mandatory release of discloseable documents. According to our records you were provided all requested documents deemed releaseable under the Act. The FOIA does not provide for agencies' interpretation of such disclosed documents and did not intend to impose such a heavy burden as the interpretation of documents.

You may wish to consult with private experts regarding these documents.

In your letter of September 30, 1975, you asked for material which had been furnished to Dr. V. P. Guinn. Please be advised that we have not provided Dr. Guinn with any Laboratory material concerning the John F. Kennedy assassination. However, inasmuch as you indicate a discrepancy between documents furnished you and those in the possession of Dr. Guinn, if you could identify those specific documents, possibly these documents could be made available to you.
