RE: Assassination of President Kennedy - Survey at 1026 N. Beckley St.,
Dallas, Texas

Reference is made to memorandum submitted May 28, 1964 relative to survey made
1026 N. Beckley at the request of Mr. Joe Ball of the Warren Commission.

On June 8, 1964 I personally talked to Mrs. Earline Roberts who stated that
had been trying to adjust the television set located in the front right corner
the living room at 1026 N. Beckley, Dallas, Texas, when she heard a car horn,
that she just stepped to the left of the television and leaned to the left and
looked through the front living room window next to the television set, at which
time she saw Lee Harvey Oswald standing near the bus stop which is just across the
sidewalk and past the driveway to 1026 N. Beckley which is on the right hand side
of the house looking from the house to North Beckley Street. Mrs. Roberts stated
that at the time she looked out of the window she was probably only a couple of
feet from the window. Her position has been indicated on copy of the rough sketch
prepared by SA Roger C. Warner, original of which was forwarded with my memorandum
May 28, 1964.
