

Atom Spy Bid ^{Post} 1-8-64

NEW YORK—The U.S. Court of Appeals reserved decision on atom spy Morton Sobell's eighth attempt to win freedom from his 30-year prison sentence.

Sobell is asking that the seven months he served in jail before sentencing, after he could not raise \$100,000 bail, be credited to the time he has served.

If the court rules in his favor, he would be eligible for parole this Friday. He was sentenced in 1951.
