Costner razzed for 'Robin Hood'

HOLLYWOOD - Kevin Costner took a quick trip from the top of the film world to the bottom Sunday, receiving one of the worst dishonors in the movie business a year after winning its leading prize.

Costner, whose "Dances With Wolves" won last year's Academy Award for best picture, was chosen worst actor in this year's Golden Raspberry Award voting.

Like the other Razzie losers, Costner failed to show up for the light-hearted ceremony where he could have received a \$1.79 plastic statuette in the annual spoof of the

Oscar proceedings.

Costner's loss came for his performance in a film Razzie voters satirically retitled "Robin Hood, Prince of Dweebs." He edged out Bruce Willis by one vote in the closest count in the 12-year history of the

Razzies, which are chosen by 350 movie buffs in 27 states and five foreign countries.

Meanwhile, movie buffs who stayed away from "Hudson Hawk"

also were vindicated.

The Willis picture was one of the year's two multiple losers, dishonored with Razzies for worst picture, worst screenplay and worst director (Michael Lehmann). This sad showing was only the latest big disappointment for the \$65 million "Hudson Hawk," which earned less than one-third of its cost before being pulled from theaters.

The other multiple loser was "A Kiss Before Dying," with actress Sean Young pulling off an unprecedented Razzie double. Ms. Young took the year's two female dishonors, receiving the supporting Razzie for her lousy work as a woman who is murdered and the worst actress Razzie for her equally bad effort as the woman's twin, who survives.
