The Christic Institute monthly forum presents authors Newman and Lifton speaking on the topic: "JFK: Breaking new Ground" which will cover: A) Kennedy's determination to avoid land war in Southeast Asia and his realization that by late 1962 U.S. efforts there had failed, B) "Back-channels" to Vice-President Johnson, C) Evidence that the deceptive handling of JFK's body could not be attributed to anything less than treason on the part of individuals at the highest levels of U.S. government.

The controversy swirling around the Oliver Stone film, JFK, makes clear the need for exacting scientific and historical analysis of the Kennedy assassination. Individually these two highly respected researchers have broken new ground and set the standard for investigation and inquiry. In combination, their research illuminates the nexus of motive and mechanics like never before.

John Newman, a Major in the U.S. Army, has published extensively in Soviet, Chinese and Asian affairs. He has three degrees in East Asian history, including a doctorate from George Washington University. Both his doctoral dissertation and his book are based upon fifteen years of painstaking research into the Vietnam War during the Kennedy administration.

David Lifton, a scientist by training, in 1981 published his book on the medical evidence that Kennedy's body was medically altered. Both Newman and KLifton will be available for interviews before and after their appearance.
