Dear J.B.Stoner,

Thanks for your letter of the ~~27th~~ 25th.

The so-called Psychological Stress Evaluator is much more subjective than the polygraph. The "operator" can interpret almost any way he wants to.

The black caucus reportedly has launched a fight to help these characters. They have been censored by Lane on the King assassination. I have no personal knowledge of this. It was a weekend radio news item. On the censoring I do ~~not~~ have knowledge. It is fact.

The bad there does not seem to be a good chance of a real investigation by these people.

I was in Washington today but for other purposes so I did not have time to check into the committee status. It is not only my impression that the committee will be continued but at a lower funding than asked. It is the opinion of these reporters who call me from time to time.

I have a notion that when there is a continuation, whatever the funding, Sprague will beat his chest, proclaim that he has done all he can and return to the much more profitable practice he can have.

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
Dear Mr. Weisberg:
