advised that she is employed by _____, Dallas, Texas,
in _____ as a long-distance operator.

She stated that on November 22, 1963, between 12 o'clock Noon and just prior to hearing that President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY was shot; exact time not recalled, she handled a call to _____ or BRUNER in Mexico City, Mexico, from a _____ in Dallas, Texas. She said she could not recall the name of the individual in Dallas who placed this call or the telephone number but that this person stated the call was an "emergency." She said that it took approximately five minutes to get the call through to Mexico City and when the party from Mexico City came on the line she overheard the individual from Dallas tell _____ or _____ "He's dead, he's dead." She did not hear any more of the conversation, however, the individual in Dallas while waiting for the call to go through was talking to someone else, and there appeared to be a great deal of noise in the background as if a lot of people were talking. She said this call to Mexico City lasted approximately one minute.

_____ advised that she is _____ 681 and was certain that the name _____ or _____ would appear on the toll ticket in addition to the name of the person making the call from Dallas inasmuch as this was a person-to-person call. She said that this call was not placed from a pay station.

She did not know how the telephone company files their toll tickets but assumes that they are filed by the name of the person to whom the telephone is registered and possibly by telephone number. She said that this toll ticket might possibly be located in the _____ files by contacting an official of this company.

_____ advised that LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK L. RUBY were unknown to her prior to seeing them on television and in the newspaper after President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY was assassinated.
