I made extra copies of the enclosures by mistake, but because the more I think about this the more I wonder, so I send them FYI in the event they may represent a policy determination that can be of interest to you.

For example, on fee waiver, if you request it.

While with any bureaucracy anything may happen, I am not willing to try to explain their selection of this one of countless appeals, all years overdue, that out of the blue is selected for adverse determination.

I've been told that the Reagan administration has decided not to grant any fee waivers. I know of none that have been.

I don't even remember requesting this one, but my not finding a copy does not necessaritly mean that I didn't.

Nobody ever spoke to me about it, or wrote me. It was not acknowledged, either, if I filed it.

If you recall that I wrote I'd made a copy of your excellent chapter on FBI files for my lawyer, he shares my opinion of its excellence and regarets very much not having it earlier, for some litigation. He also is unable to locate a copy of your book. Do you know if Temple can provide one?
