Thanks for doing your Echo Sorrelation article on the sounds of bullets in the JFK assassination.

I write to wall your attention to the fact that all the HSCA testing was made on the presumption that all but one of the shots were fired from the TSBD, The sup pressed fact established beyond reasonable question is that none was fired from there. I have the suppressed proofs from only official sources,, largely as the result of about a dozen FOIA lawsuits from which I got about a third of a million pages. Would knowing that there should have been tests addressing other possible sources of the shots have been likely to produce other possible points of origin?

If a different rifle or rifles had been used, with different bullets, as certianly is true, is there any testing that can produce other results?

And if silencers were used on rifles?

If any of this interests you or if you would like to ask me any questions, please do so. I do not tell you more now because I am 88, feeble, and still trying to do the best I can to make and leave a record for history with what I can do now.
