Mrs. JEAN OTT, 1503 Denton Drive, Carrollton, Texas, advised that at approximately 8 p.m. on the evening of November 21, 1963, GLEN (Last Name Unknown), who was employed as a cook at Kohl's Drive-in, 1015 Josey Lane, Carrollton, Texas, remarked in her presence that there was one vulnerable place along the proposed parade route of President KENNEDY where "they could get him and that was at the underpass".

ROSE GLEN WILLIAMS, Cook, Kohl's Drive-In, 1015 Josey Lane, Carrollton, Texas, advised that he did remark on the evening of November 21, 1963, that the underpass over Industrial Boulevard near the Trade Mart Building in Dallas, Texas, would be the place to "get" the President if someone wanted to assassinate him. WILLIAMS stated that he had no such intention nor did he know of anyone else who might have been connected with the crime, and he did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD or anyone else connected with the assassination of the President. He explained that he had a premonition something would happen to the President and explained that he had a similar premonition a short time ago with regard to his grandmother who died a short time later.
