Mr. OSCAR S. WYATT, Chairman of the Board of Coastal States Gas Products Company, Houston and Corpus Christi, Texas, who described himself as an intimate personal friend of President LYNDON D. JOHNSON and an admirer and acquaintance of ex-President JOHN F. KENNEDY, advised that he and JOHN HENRY HILL had promoted the election campaign of Mr. KENNEDY when convention interest was initially lacking. Mr. WYATT stated that both he and HILL made sizeable financial contributions to Mr. KENNEDY's campaign.

WYATT advised that he currently has oil interests in conjunction with the KENNEDY family and that he and HILL would have taken the initiative through current personal contacts with President JOHNSON and other members of the KENNEDY administration of advising them of any remarks detrimental to the safety and well-being of former President KENNEDY.
