

Robert Mahon Associates/CIA Domestic; Radio & TV Reports; 1964 election 3/27/76

This is a repetition of something Russ Trunzo told me long ago. I may have made no notes then. He was here last night and this morning.

Prior to the nomination, Rockefeller contacted with Goldwater in 1964.

With a highly-sophisticated staff of 23 men headquartered in Rockefeller Center Mahon Associates worked for Rocky. Mahon approached R-TV Rpts to obtain typed transcripts of everything Goldwater said. These were bought on tape from AP and UPI, transcribed and sold to Mahon.

For R-TV R this was a nice deal. It had to do no monitoring or taping. It had only the transcribing to do.

Later Mahon's people called R-TV R to ask if they could do the same thing in L.W.Abel's effort to oust David McDonald as Steel Workers' president. However, then AP and UPI would not be covering every spoken word. This meant that R-TV R would have to have someone going around and taping McDonald. This was not that easy, so Russ, then Chicago manager, made an arrangement with WCAU, Pittsburg, to cover for them. This gave him a legitimate cover and he did receive nominal sums from WCAU.

He finds it curious that Mahon represented both Rocky and McDonald at the same time. And I think he was also tied in with CIA at this time.

The McDonald deal was that Mahon would pay all costs + tapes, transcripts, postage (special delivery daily to many cities) and the cost of rented equipment. "We were mailing those things all over the country."

Mahon did not pay the last \$5,000 of the bill. Ultimately it was settled for about 10¢ on the dollar.

Once Russ was transcribing a Drew Pearson book for someone who wanted it in a hurry, Pearson reported a piece Mrs. Goldwater had in Ladies Home Journal in which she spoke of Barry's several nervous breakdowns. When Russ reported this to the Mahon people they sent all 20 staffers out to buy every copy of the issue in New York City. Mahon, NY mgr of R-TV R was later in the Mahon office. He saw all those stacks of the magazine. But Russ recalls no use of any when it could have been so hurtful to Goldwater or helpful to Rocky.
