Penn Jones' version of what he heard of Underhill's death was that a CIA man appeared at a New York friend of long-standing (John Devenan) in a distraught state within days after the assassination, and told her (probably Mrs. Fitzsimmons) "I know who killed Kennedy and you have to hide me." He returned to Washington, to his home and wife within a week or two and about three months later he committed suicide. Shot himself in his home.
