

## Gray Says Nixon Was Informed

WASHINGTON (AP) — Former acting FBI director L. Patrick Gray informed President Nixon about White House involvement in Watergate shortly after the break-in at Democratic National headquarters, according to news accounts.

The Baltimore Sun, in Saturday editions, said Gray telephoned Nixon shortly after the bugging raid. The Sun, quoting federal sources, said Gray told investigators he received "no reaction" from the President when he expressed his concern that the FBI and CIA were being "used" by persons close to the White House.

Similar accounts, also quoting sources, were publicized by the New York Daily News and ABC television.
