The following exhibit is one prepared in an attempt to obtain and tabulate the vehicles observed in and around Dealy Plaza on November 22, 1963. The results of the research to date is as follows:

-of these 8 license numbers are known and listed -the breakdown is 4 vans or trucks, 4 station wagons, 1 boxcar, and 11 various makes and models of cars -the total number of vehicles found that may have played a part in the assassination is 20 -4 of these vehicles either had rifles present in them or suspects exited from them carrying rifles

-3 cars had out-of-state license plates, one being identified as the state of Georgia -11 vehicles were wanted by the Dallas Police -some cars acceared to be radio equipped

-this station wagon vicked up at least two individuals in the area of Dealy Plaza -at least 3 suspects were apprehended by the Dallas Folice, names unknown -4 different people report seeing a 1951 or 1962 white Rambler station waron between 12:30 and 1:00 P.M.
