SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT

It was noted that when [redacted] was interviewed at his residence which is the [redacted] advised that after losing contact with LEE HARVEY OSWALD in 1956, he had not seen him or heard from him or heard anything about him until he heard OSWALD's name mentioned in reference to the assassination of the President. b7D

In view of the fact that [redacted] had been one of OSWALD's only friends during the time OSWALD attended Beauregard Junior High, [redacted] was asked to explain why he did not notice information concerning OSWALD when OSWALD had been arrested for distributing pro-Cuban leaflets on Canal Street last summer. b7D

[redacted] replied at this time that he had been out of town. In answer to questions by interviewing agents, [redacted] explained he had been to Mexico on the Yucatan Peninsula during August, 1963, with a group of individuals from LSU. b7D

[redacted] was not questioned concerning the exact dates of this trip nor the exact cities visited nor for the identity of the persons who accompanied him on this trip as information concerning the connection of Mexico in this matter had not yet been received. b7D
