Dear John Woods, the reverse explains my limitations, which include much correspondence that does not advance my own work now. I do not have a cassette of the Bringuier debate. I cannot take time to make excerpts from Oswald in New Orleans. I have a few copies. I did not print it. I have to get \$21.00, including insured mail, for each. Generally I do not let it be known that I was able to obtain these copies and have a couple. There are edited versions of this tape kicking around. Key Records, somewhere in the Los Angeles area, had a record with parts included. The Cubans and/or the government edited it. The Archives should have at least the version of the Secret Service, which I believe obtained at least one from the right-wing Cubans. I do not know the cost but I imagine it will be as great or greater than Oswald in New Orleans. In fact, I do not know if the Archives will provide a copy because it is WDSU property, I think.
