The nature of the business and their prectise of it is such that the effect is to give it to then on consignment and then to give them a free bank account! If we had the money owed us on just these two books, we'd not have financial problems. I just had to go to the bank and borrow what for me is a veyusizeable hunk of dought, \$25,000, yet me have more than \$30,000 coming to us!

And mu printer? With this money coming to me I haven't the spare cash to may him for the job he had just done. He is decent, knew this in edvence end, knowing he'd get paid, agreed.

So, there is more than just writing a hook on an unwelcome subject to getting it out - and then raying for it.

There are those who call it scavenging!
