Dear Henry,

I've just seen several of Earl Golz's stories of a month ago.

The Lifton book of which he wrote so uncritically is entirely un-new except for the conjectures, which are attracting attention. They range from unreasonable to impossible. I know the author well. He is bright, unscrupulous and articulate. He was able to make those conjectures appear to be true by what he knew and omitted as well as by what he ignored and didn't check out. Like he says the corpse was spirited in the back gate of the hospital, only it was locked, without a guard present to open it.

Mary Moorman Bortoni is suing the Congress to get her pictures back. Her lawyer is identified as Frank Shor. If he is a friend of yours and he has trouble getting the originals, the Dallas FBI, keeping it a big secret, made copies as soon as they first saw them. I don't know if they were sent to FBIHQ in 1977, when much else was. The FBI never let the Commission know. I have those records, if he needs copies.

Last September I was operated on for an arterial blockage in the left thigh. I now have a plastic artery from the groin to the knee. That operation was quite successful, only the day I was discharged clots broke loose. Those below the ankle were not accessible to the ensuing surgery. Giving me some trouble, limited what I can do, but I feel fine, as - hope you do, and I remain fairly active. Too active for the FBI, which I still have in court in three FOIA cases. Ill be getting more Dallas records in one of them, under an agreement where it all will be done by October. If I see anything of interest to you, I'll send it.
