KGO newscast, excerpt of taped telephone interview with Warren Hinckle, managing editor of RAMPARTS magazine, the November 1966 issue of which carried articles calling for a reopening of the investigation of President Kennedy's assassination.

Hinckle -- A year ago RAMPARTS totally believed the Warren Report. After a year of investigation we totally disbelieve it. We do not accept its conclusions; we do not accept its premises; we do not accept its logic; we do not accept the facts that lead to that conclusion. We think that the Commission, for political motivations, rushed to get out an answer to the country before the presidential election in 1964, that in the course of that they discarded any evidence whatsoever that would tend to go away from their conclusion of Oswald acting alone as the single gunman who killed the President.....
