

9/24/65 Gave rib on copy to Lawrence Stern, Post, after picking up from Emerson, who had made arrangements. Em. called and I went down. Told Em arrangement earlier that am with Times and said had to tell Post, but would look out for them. Stern had date for late lunch, spoke briefly, telling him of my background, etc. and of Times. I said that if Times had interest, it was prior but would seek collateral one for Post if it desired, and if Times didn't, Post could have (such as syndication). Offered him (as I had to Wicker for Salisbury) use of my marked volumes, explaining the marking would save time. Told of Clayton, etc., brief pub history, etc. He will read fast and if I'm in town middle next week I'm to check with him. We were interrupted by arrival lunch companion. Confidential nature agreed to.
