Dear George,

Some time ago you asked for a copy of the Congressional Record in which it is explicit that the 1974 amending of the investigatory files exemption was prompted by my spectro suit. I was not then able to find my copy but later, when I found a citation to it, I left a message for you so you could locate it in the Post's morgue.

Enclosed is an internal DJ record which is pertinent to that interest. Quin Shea refers to my "unique" role in FOIA.

The other records are for your/the Post's file. They reflect the fact that all the "materials," which includes the autopsy and autopsy-related materials, were given to the GSA by the Kennedy family. I've just gotten these, in response to a 1977 request - of a different agency.

Please note the 2/65 date of this letter agreement. At that time all the autopsy-related materials were in the possession of the Secret Service and/or the FBI. The physical transfers from the Justice main building are recorded in other records I've obtained. I know of no reason to credit the officially inspired story that they were in Bobby's possession and that he is responsible for any mysterious disappearances.
