Dear Jon,

As soon as I could after the copy of Wecht's Modern Medicine promotion of 10/28/74 came I read it because you said you were going to call. I marked it up so I could be specific with you if you asked questions. I appreciate getting it because it tells me that there is nothing new and Cyril is still promoting his malpractice business with the JFK assassination.

I do hate to have to say such things. But I hate more that they are true. Even some ~~fact~~ of the stuff he says was not released until 1973 (with a strong suggestion that he caused it) I had, wrote about and carried further years ago. It simply was not secret until 1973 in all files. The trouble ~~is~~ that Cyril never really did any work and can't think of the business he'd lose if he did.

It is possible to make further efforts along the lines of disclosure and as best I can I am making them. The questions he addresses middle of middle column, 1st page, are all answered in other ways only he doesn't know the material. I had it written years ago, and definitively.

"I now believe that there has been a prolonged and willful cover-up of the Commission's failure by the government." Now? After 11 years? Not until now? And you marked that? Come now, ~~what~~ Jon! What were all the books about, beginning with my first of 9 years ago, almost 10?

"I am forced to conclude that the Justice Department is covering up the Commission's failure to solve the case." Well, the oracle has spoken. Sleep in peace, without worry.
