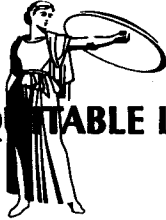

CONTRACT
between

The Department of Social and Cultural Affairs, Hunter College, City University of New York, (hereinafter Department) and Mr. Harold Weisberg.

In consideration of the respective promises herein and other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

(1) Mr. Weisberg agrees to appear at Hunter College on the 21st day of April, 1976 from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM to participate in a joint presentation with Mr. Robert Groden on the subject of the assassination of President John Kennedy.

(2) It is agreed between and understood by the parties that the format of this presentation is to be jointly devised and performed by Mr. Weisberg and Mr. Groden.

(3) The Department will pay to Mr. Weisberg, on the same 21st day of April, 1976 the sum of Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$950).

(4) This contract shall be valid and binding upon both parties, and each respective party shall make every effort to comply with its terms. In the event of circumstances preventing such presentation on the date above stated (including but not limited to student demonstrations such as occurred at the time of Mr. Groden's appearance during the 1975 Spring term) this contract will not be void but will continue and remain binding, subject to a mutually agreed-upon date in the reasonable future.

(5) This contract sets forth the entire agreement between the parties. The signing of this agreement by the parties constitutes their mutual recognition that no other contract or agreements, oral or written, exists between them.

(6) In the event of cancellation of this contract by the Department for any other cause than that stated in Paragraph (4) or other unforeseeable contingency which would render performance impossible, payment in full will be made under terms as set forth in Paragraph (3).

(7) This agreement has been made under and shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York.

(8) This agreement totally replaces the contract between the Department and Mr. Weisberg wherein the performance was scheduled for the 17th day of March, 1976.

In witness whereof the respective parties hereunto set their hand. Signatories for the Department of Social and Cultural Affairs have been duly authorized by the Department to execute this contract.
