

Dear Ian MacFarlane- because you'll be in New Zealand for a month, sending you WW IV by surface mail will save you money. The total cost, US, will be about \$6.50. Until I take the Australian bill to the bank and they dispose of it I have no way of knowing its US value. If it presents no great problem for you, I think the best means is by a check drawn on a US bank. If you give US money to your post office, they do not transmit it, ours does not recognize it, and the cost to me is 15¢ or more. Through their banks others do this. Some British businesses maintain New York bank accounts for this simplifying of problems. Perhaps it can be done down under, too? Best W 11/19/74
