You refer to a JFK ~~ex~~ lecture there. By whom? Do you think they'll really hold a symposium? Of the Lanes and Liftons perhaps?

While I have no personal knowledge, I believe I did hear that all JFK assassi - nation references were deleted from the McCallo tapes.

In your various comments about Ray, that he always lies is not my experience or observation. He may lie a bit but he evades in preference. The stuff HSCA used against him I got and earlier had taken up with him. Mike on the laundry, he persisted in telling me that he had gone to Atlanta to get it and that he had left it earlier. The few reviews I've noted on Gawwaw concentrated on the "Mala" line or like The Solo News said it "proved" R.F.K. was "responsible" with J.F.K.! Gawwaw praises The F.B.I. with faint damns.

The S. Evening Post even has an article justifying what The F.B.I. did to Jean Seberg. The "Alaska" in Regan's Cabinet is the guy Hoover wanted to replace King with!

The King case. Ray, in my view, was part of the conspiracy and since he always lies, what chance can one give him? A high level conspiracy could set up a relatively low level conspiracy. May have killed King.

Even when I was in Florida there was talk of "killing" King and on the basis of the H.S.C.A. "logic", funerals were quiet - a minimum figure! - "since Ray could have feared of the 'offense'".

Could there be any link between the case involving murder of John Paul Spica and Memphis? The Ray stabbing and Memphis?

" Instead of legal authorities, Harold Weisberg was brought forward and offered as an assassin, "bug to charge" that I was "totally amoral". Weisberg had previously stated that he was working for The F.B.I., although that was omitted by Newsweek."

" So I wrote home in his "exoneration" from Jonestown, The Strongest Prison.

It's not only this kind of violation but the absence of any book detailing the people, events and perspective of that time which could make a memoir both fascinating and very committal. It was tragic and yet - hilarious, also.

One can note the de-cycling and theories in Fucini's The Spymaster to catch the "thermal". To the birds it's all new stuff.

A girl who knew nothing of my interest in the subject told me she was "reading The expose of Dallas, Farewell, America". Queen's has copies but it was banned in America!"

They believe this stuff and the failure of The D.F. to be open the case gave credence to the nuts.
