They requested a \$5.00 registration fee to defray processing costs" and this was sent to them on April 13, 1968 and I recall receiving a "Political Opinion Survey" shortly after this. I did not make a copy of this survey, but basically it requested my opinion on the popularity of Robert Kennedy and several other questions concerning the possibility of becoming president. I completed the survey and sent it in to World Field Research. I never had any more correspondence from them in any form. I of course received no payment for this "research" either. This all seemed to me just a "con-artist" at work picking up \$5.00 a head until the news of Robert Kennedy's assassination. Perhaps it has nothing at all to do with his death but I thought if you had been investigating it then you might find it of some use. If not, well I'm sorry to have troubled you, but you know there are many people here in Canada who were I'm sure just as grieved as Americans over the Kennedy's death. I am enclosing some of the brochures from World Field Research which I have kept.
