It deals principally with an explanation for the reissuance of a round trip ticket to one of the passengers on bus on which Oswald traveled from Mexico City to Laredo on 10/2-3/63. Heretofore, the ticketing of the passenger in question was improperly described by an employee of the Mexican bus line.
