Dear Senator Russell:

Mr. Jesse Curry, the Chief of Police of Dallas in November, 1963, now retired, has recently released a book.

The book is entitled "Retired Dallas Police Chief Jesse Curry reveals his personal JFK Assassination File." This book presents to the public that there are no facts upon which to establish that Lee H. Oswald killed the President, and that Curry has never had the proof of it.

I do believe that on such an issue the public deserves nothing that will add to fallacy and contradiction.

Possibly you do not know that in my home window today is the perfect bullet hole through a copper strip in the window that would produce better evidence regarding the gun used, than that which the Dallas police got in the form of a bullet that was so mutilated, it was unrecognizable after having passed through a masonry wall.
